The African Refugee Development Center is a grassroots, community-based, nonprofit organization that was founded in 2004 by African asylum seekers and Israeli citizens, in order to assist, protect and empower African refugees and asylum seekers in Israel.

To date, the ARDC has served over 10,000 refugees and asylum seekers from a number of countries including Eritrea, Sudan, The Democratic Republic of Congo, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Ethiopia and the Ivory Coast.

ABOUT AFRICAN ASYLUM SEEKERS

Asylum seekers are a relatively new phenomenon in Israel, with only a couple of marginal examples recorded since the establishment of the State. This changed drastically between 2006 and 2012, when more than 60,000 African asylum seekers crossed the Egyptian border through Sinai desert and into Israel. Besides encountering horrific perils in their home countries and en route to Israel, the government of Israel has employed various policies to pressure asylum seekers to leave – including indefinite arbitrary detention, refusal to accept and review asylum claims, limitation of access to basic state-sponsored services, incitement and coerced repatriation.
