### **Guidance from IRCC for Private Sponsors Regarding COVID-19**

IRCC have produced a document intended to assist sponsors in understanding how refugee sponsorship applications in process are affected by COVID-19 and, for sponsored newcomers that have already arrived in Canada, how sponsors can continue to fulfill their sponsorship role while also addressing the unique settlement needs of the newcomers during this difficult time.

If sponsors have case specific questions that are not addressed in the document at the link above, they should contact the following IRCC departments directly:

- Pre-arrival questions (i.e. for applications currently in process): contact the Resettlement Operations Centre – Ottawa (ROC-O) via email; or,
- Post-arrival (i.e. for sponsored newcomers that have already arrived in Canada and are within their sponsorship period): contact the Resettlement Services Assurance Team (RSAT) via email.

#### One Time Increase to the Canada Child Benefit Payments for May 2020

Families receiving the Canada Child Benefit (CCB) will receive an extra \$300 per child in May 2020 as part of their regular monthly payment to assist with the pressures caused by COVID-19.

The increase is a one-time payment and families who already receive the CCB do not need to apply for this increase as it will be administered as part of the regular payment for May 2020. Newcomers sponsored under the Private Sponsorship of Refugees (PSR) and Blended Visa Office-Referred (BVOR) programs who are <u>eligible</u> for the CCB, along with the <u>GST/HST credit</u>, should apply for these tax benefits immediately after their arrival in Canada.

Sponsored newcomers <u>should not</u> wait for when they file their tax returns to apply for the CCB or the GST/HST credit.

Sponsors can assist sponsored newcomers with applying for the CCB and the GST/HST credit, but most <u>settlement</u> <u>agencies</u> are also able to assist the newcomers with applying for these tax benefits.

### Question

Can sponsors make deductions from the monthly income support they provide based on sponsored newcomers receiving funds from the CCB or other provincial/territorial tax benefits or rebates?

#### **Answer**

No, sponsors <u>cannot</u> make deductions from the monthly income support they provide to newcomers sponsored under the PSR and BVOR programs based on the newcomers receiving payments from the CCB or other provincial/territorial tax benefit or rebate programs.

As noted in Q.15 of the <u>FAQs on Post-Arrival Financial</u> <u>Support for PSRs</u>, the CCB, along with other provincial/territorial tax benefits or rebates, are not considered to be earned income and the receipt of these tax benefits or rebates has no impact on the minimum amount of financial support a sponsor is expected to provide.

# How to Submit a PSR Application to ROC-O Via Email

If you are submitting a new PSR sponsorship application to ROC-O, you are strongly advised to do so via email so the application can be processed.

Please ensure that all new PSR applications are complete, and all the required forms and supporting documents are included with the application package, as currently there are no exemptions from the application requirements for new PSR applications being submitted to ROC-O.
