## The New Testing Requirements and Sponsored Refugees

As of February 22, 2021, all persons entering Canada by air, including sponsored refugees, are required to take a COVID-19 molecular test on arrival and stay in a government-authorized hotel for three nights while waiting for the results of the test.

After receiving the results, the travellers will be required to <u>quarantine</u> or <u>isolate</u> for the remainder of the 14-day period (the 14 days starts from the date of arrival in Canada).

These requirements <u>apply even if the travellers have</u> <u>been vaccinated for COVID-19</u>.

For sponsored refugees, an <u>IRCC funded Service</u> <u>Provider Organization (SPO)</u> will coordinate the hotel bookings and transportation to the hotel. At the hotel, the sponsored refugees will be provided with food and will have access to Wi-Fi and phones. The cost of the hotel stay and transportation will be covered by IRCC.

Sponsors will not be able to visit the refugees while they are staying at the hotel but can communicate with them via the phone and/or video calls (if they already have a laptop, smartphone or tablet) during their stay.

Sponsors should contact the refugees during their three-night stay at the government-authorized hotel to ensure they have arrived safely, understand what to expect during their stay at the hotel and to ensure that they have <u>reported their arrival</u> at the hotel via <u>ArriveCAN</u> or by calling 1-833-641-0343 (toll-free).

#### If the Test is Negative

If a negative COVID-19 test result is received, the sponsored refugees will continue travelling to their final destination, where they will be required to quarantine for the remainder of the 14-day period.

Sponsors should make arrangements to transport the refugees from their final destination to their place of quarantine. If the hotel is already in the community of settlement, sponsors should make arrangements to transport the refugees from the hotel to their place of quarantine.

Towards the end of the quarantine period, the refugees must take a second COVID-19 test provided by the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC). The second test is self-administered, and instructions will be provided by PHAC on how to take the test and send it back.

The refugees are required to stay in their place of quarantine until the quarantine period has ended and a second negative test result is received.

#### If the Test is Positive

If a positive COVID-19 test result is received, the refugees will be transferred to a PHAC-administered quarantine facility in the city where they landed and they will be required to <u>isolate for the remainder of the 14-day period</u>.

The cost of this will be paid for by the Government of Canada.
