You Asked

Will sponsored refugees arriving in New Brunswick need to quarantine at a hotel for 7 days when they arrive in the province?

Answer

As of April 24, 2021, non-essential travellers and people moving to New Brunswick (NB) must quarantine for at least 7 days at a designated facility in the province and take additional COVID-19 tests before quarantining at home for the remainder of the 14 days.

Sponsored refugees whose final destination is in NB and have a pre-approved quarantine plan are exempted from the 7-day hotel stay and the additional provincial testing requirements.

However, they must still <u>quarantine for 14 days</u> <u>after arriving in the province</u> in accordance with provincial public health guidelines.

You Asked

What can sponsors do if there are issues with scheduling pick-ups for the Day 8 test with Purolater?

Answer

Sponsors can drop the test sample off at a designated drop box if there are issues with arranging a pickup time with Purolater.

You Asked

Is there any additional information on why IRCC is asking for a IMM 0006 form?

Answer

Sponsored refugees travelling to Canada under the Extended Family Members (EFM) exemption to the travel restrictions are required to travel with a copy of the completed IMM 0006 form in case issues arise during travel or at the Port of Entry.

To be eligible for the <u>exemption</u>, **all** refugees on the application must meet <u>the requirements</u>, including the Principal Applicant (PA), the PA's spouse/common law partner and any dependent children.

All refugees travelling under the <u>exemption</u> must complete the IMM 0006 form, including dependent children. The PA can complete and sign the form on behalf of any dependent children if they are minors.

Please note that IRCC are not asking sponsors to identify refugees that are eligible for the <u>EFM</u> <u>exemption</u> at this time; IRCC will identify eligible refugees.
