Information on the Special Programs for Afghan Nationals

Canada has announced the resettlement of 20,000 vulnerable Afghan nationals to Canada.

This will be done through:

- A special immigration program for Afghan nationals, and their families, who assisted the Government of Canada in Afghanistan; and,
- A special humanitarian program focused on resettling vulnerable Afghan refugees who are <u>outside</u> of Afghanistan and who do not have a durable solution in a third country.

Resettlement for the special humanitarian program for Afghan refugees <u>outside</u> of Afghanistan will be via the Private Sponsorship of Refugees (PSR) and the Government Assisted Refugees (GAR) programs.

Please note that Afghan refugees being sponsored via the PSR program must meet all the eligibility and admissibility requirements of the program; there are currently no exemptions from any of the requirements.

Excluded Family Members Pilot Extended

The public policy pilot for excluded family members has been extended for an additional two years.

The pilot now ends on September 09, 2023.

The pilot program enables individuals to sponsor their spouse, partner or child that would otherwise be excluded from coming to Canada because they were not originally included on their application to become a permanent resident.

Applications under the pilot are submitted via the family class. Information about family class sponsorship is available here.

As a reminder, Sponsorship Agreement Holders (SAHs), along with their CGs and co-sponsors, Groups of Five and Community Sponsors <u>must</u> include the <u>Principal Applicant's family members</u> on the refugee sponsorship application (either as accompanying or non-accompanying), even if they are missing, presumed dead or in detention.

The consequences for not doing so are detailed here.
