FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: I still have not received my training certificate. Could you help me?

A: Certificates are sent automatically to participants an hour after the end of the session. Please make sure to check the email address that you have used to register for the session.

Also, check your junk or spam folder, and contact us if you need further help.

Q: How does one appoint a representative?

A: To appoint a representative in the expected community of settlement:

- complete the Appointment of Representative(s) form [IMM 5956] (PDF, 1.56 MB) [Download PDF Here](#)
- submit a copy of a photo identification document (ID) with the address of the representative (for example, a driver's license or provincial and territorial photo cards)
- If the ID does not contain the address of the representative, then submit an additional document with the ID showing their residential address

Q: How long will it take to process these applications? Are they being prioritized?

A: Applications submitted under this special program will be prioritized as part of IRCC's current commitment to resettle Afghan refugees. We don't know precisely how long it will take to finalize applications, as it depends on various factors, including the political situations where Afghan refugees reside.
