SUPPORTING LGBTQ2+ REFUGEES: THE RAINBOW REFUGEE ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP & BVOR PROGRAM

Did you know that LGBTQ2+ refugees face unique challenges and persecution in many parts of the world?

We are committed to creating a safe and inclusive space for all, including LGBTQ2+ refugees.

Here's how YOU can make a difference:

 The Rainbow Refugee Assistance Partnership (RRAP) is a collaborative blended refugee sponsorship initiative that enables LGBTQ2+ refugees who are fleeing violence and persecution to be sponsored for resettlement to Canada. The RRAP is administered by <u>Rainbow</u> Refugee and was introduced in June 2019, building on the Rainbow Refugee Assistance Pilot. Through this partnership, the Government of Canada provides start-up costs and three months of monthly income support, with sponsors providing the remaining nine months of monthly income support. Sponsors also provide the refugees with vital settlement and emotional support to ensure a smooth and successful settlement process.






