NEW HUMANITARIAN PATHWAY FOR PERSONS AFFECTED BY THE CONFLICT **IN SUDAN**

On December 28, 2023, the Government of Canada announced a new family-based humanitarian pathway to permanent residence for persons who resided in Sudan when the conflict began on April 15, 2023.

To be eligible, the Principal Applicant

- April 15, 2023. • Be outside of Canada the time the

- Intend to live in a province or territory other than Quebec.
- Not have a durable solution available to them within a reasonable period of time.
- Be a child (of any age), grandchild, parent, grandparent, or sibling of a Canadian citizen or permanent resident who is living in Canada. Have their family member in
- Canada agree to support them for one year after arrival and have provided a statutory declaration from the family member that attests *Note: If the applicant is in Canada,

- permanent resident who is 18 years or older. • Live in Canada outside of Quebec.
- Be eligible (i.e., is not subject of a removal order, not detained, have no criminal convictions, not in default of any sponsorship undertakings or support payments and is not receiving social assistance other than disability).

• Meets the financial requirements

- and agrees to support the Principal Applicant and any accompanying family members for one year after their arrival in Canada. Has not, and will not, accept any financial compensation from the




