Blended Visa Office-Referred (BVOR) Program
Refugees sponsored through the BVOR program are eligible for the following income support benefits from IRCC for six months: • Basic Needs Allowance • Shelter Allowance and Housing Supplement • Communication Allowance • Transportation Allowance • Maternity Food Allowance (if applicable) • Special Dietary Allowance (if applicable) The costs for the remaining six months, including Start-Up Costs and additional special expenses as required, are provided by the sponsoring group.

Transportation Rates
Charlottetown https://www.t3transit.ca/fares Transportation allowance is provided to each adult, including seniors, as per the rate of public transit for adults and seniors in their community, or a minimum of \$83.71/month, whichever is greater. For rates, consult the links above.
Note: In communities where there is no public transit, a flat transportation rate of \$83.71/month is issued.
