Housing Supplement: Up to a maximum of \$500/month* may be issued when actual housing costs exceed the Shelter Allowance. *The Housing Supplement is to be calculated by subtracting the Shelter Allowance and 43% of the Canada Child Benefit (CCB) (where applicable) from actual housing costs.

Blended Visa Office-Referred (BVOR) Program

Refugees sponsored through the BVOR program are eligible for the following income support benefits from IRCC for six months:

- Basic Needs Allowance
- Shelter Allowance and Housing Supplement
- Communication Allowance
- Transportation Allowance
- Maternity Food Allowance (if applicable)
- Special Dietary Allowance (if applicable)

The costs for the remaining six months, including Start-Up Costs and additional special expenses as required, are provided by the sponsoring group.
